This work contains an informal presentation of the customary elements of logic, but places emphasis upon their practical application to the dramatic, as well as formal aspects of argumentation. Lengthy examples are presented which range from Pascal's « The Wager » to Warren's « Brown vs. Board of Education of Topeka ». Each selection is followed by suggestions for discussion and writing. The work should prove valuable to those who wish to treat the introductory logic course more as an applied study of reasoning than as a study of formal systems.
